Complaints Procedure

Any member who feels the Club Rules, Policies or Codes have been broken or they have suffered discrimination should report to the Welfare Officer including the following information:

- When, where and what occurrence took place;
- Any witness' names and contact details and any statements.
- Names of others who have been treated in a similar way.
- Details of any former complaints about the incident.
- A preference for a solution to the incident.

The Club's Welfare Officer has the power to appoint a disciplinary sub-committee to sit for any hearings that are required. They will report their findings to the Club's Welfare Officer who will have the power to:

- Warn as to future conduct
- Suspend from membership
- Remove from membership

Any person found to have broken the Club's Rules, Policies or Codes of Conduct will be subject to disciplinary action.
